CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

We aim to limit inconveniences while we work. As we work, you'll notice:

- Utility line marking and survey holes.
- Road, sidewalk and lane closures.
- Workers, equipment and construction materials.
- Access changes.
- Noise.

Some areas may experience temporary utility service interruptions.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Public safety is at the foundation of all we do. The safety of the public around our infrastructure influences every decision we make. We take a proactive approach to public safety by implementing safety measures before, during and after construction.

If you suspect a natural gas leak, leave your location immediately.

If you see downed electric lines do not touch the lines or anyone or anything in contact with them. Clear the area immediately and contact Xcel Energy's emergency hotline at 800-895-1999.
